Second Chance would like to extend an invitation for your child to participate in the 2016-2017 Extended School Year Program (ESYP). Your son/daughter will begin the program June 5, 2017 and end on June 22, 2017. The operating days will be Monday through Thursday. Complimentary breakfast will be served beginning at 8:00 a.m. Class will start promptly at 8:30 a.m. Students will not be accepted into class after 8:30a.m. without a note from a parent. Complimentary lunch will be served at 12:00p.m. Leon County **will not** provide transportation. ***However, all Leon County students may ride STAR Metro for free with a student i.d.; which we can help them obtain.***

Students who participate in the academic program will be given an opportunity to recover academic credits, gain additional elective credit, prepare for the PERT, or begin preparation to study for the GED. This year's enrichment program will be both educational and fun. Students will engage in off campus excursions to a variety of sites that will promote scientific interaction and environmental consciousness in our community. The enrichment component of the program will start at 12:30p.m and end at 3:00p.m. The enrichment component is optional, but strongly encouraged. Social and personal development will be addressed by promoting positive interactions among peers as well as enhancing social skills, learning how to build stronger relationships by improving conflict resolution strategies. Students who attend both the academic and enrichment program can earn community service hours.
