Below is a summary of each option:

OPTION 1	Keeps the same basic calendar as for school year 2016-2017 (including Fall Holiday). (Ends first nine-weeks one week earlier to better balance first two nine-week grading periods.)*
OPTION 2	Begins school year earlier in August (on earliest allowed date per FS), includes Fall Holiday, pro- vides a full week ( <i>for teachers and students</i> ) for Thanksgiving Holidays, and ends school year ( <i>for students</i> ) after Memorial Day Holiday.
OPTION 3	A blend of Options 1 and 2. Keeps same school start calendar as 2016-17, includes Fall Holiday, provides a full week <i>(for teachers and students)</i> for Thanksgiving Holidays, and ends school year <i>(for students)</i> on June 1.
*All options do this.
