The following list is a generic supply list.

Specific course items will be provided during the first week of classes.

- ✓ 1 three ring binder (1"or larger), with pockets, clear plastic cover sleeve and additional pocket folders to add inside
- √ 1 set of dividers
- 1 pack of highlighters
- √ 1 box of colored pencils
- √ 1 small (hand held) pencil sharpener with compartment for pencil shavings for desk use
- √ 1 standard/metric ruler
- √ 1 package of graph paper
- ✓ 2-3 dry erase markers
- ✓ Flash Drive (any USB Saving Device)
- √ 1 ream of standard white printing paper
- ✓ 1 bound composition book
- ✓ Additional binders/folders may be required depending on the student's schedule
- ✓ Generous supply of notebook paper, pencils, and pens (blue/black ink recommended)
- ✓ Boxes of Tissues
- ✓ Belt (for our young men as they are required to wear a belt and tuck in their shirt)
- ✓ 4 function calculator with square root, percent and integer buttons (integer buttons may resemble +/-)

Suggested Home Materials: paper, poster board, metric ruler, pencils, pens, glue, scissors, colored pencils and markers.

<u>Backpacks</u>: Backpacks are not allowed to be taken into the classrooms. For the schools purpose, a backpack is defined as any bag containing two straps designed to be carried over one or both shoulders. All backpacks must fit in the lockers. The dimensions of lockers are 36hx12wx12d or 24hx12wx12d.

<u>Agenda Books</u>: All students are required to have an Agenda Book. The first agenda book will be provided to students free of cost.

Any additional agenda book will be available for a cost of \$5.00.

All school locks are provided for each child to rent at a cost of \$2.00. Replacement locks may be provided at a cost of \$5.00

Students should not bring all their supplies on the first day of school. Back packs will not be permitted during the 1<sup>st</sup> week of school. In fact, lockers are not usually issued until Friday of the first week. During the first week of classes have your child bring only the basics (i.e. what he/she will not mind carrying around with them all day) until instructed otherwise by specific teachers.
