Dear Math Teachers and Principals,

Your school is invited to attend the Montford/Cobb 6^{th} Grade Mini Mu Math Competition on Saturday, October 22^{nd} 2016. Sixth and seventh grade students are invited to participate. This year's contest will be held at Montford Middle School.

There will be two rounds of testing. All students will take the same test. Each round will consist of 25 multiple-choice questions. No calculators are allowed. Answer sheets will be provided. There is a \$10 registration fee for each student.

Scoring:

Five points will be awarded for every correct answer
One point will be awarded for every question left unanswered
Zero points will be awarded for each incorrect answer

We will attempt to make the test questions challenging but reasonable.

Awards:

This is a "friendly" contest. You will receive results for everyone but may award trophies to your own students. Trophies will be given to each school that participates to award to their high scoring students. Two trophies will be available for each ten students who are registered from each school.

Frequently Asked Questions

Does my school have to have a certain number of students to participate in the Mini-Mu?

 No, there is no minimum number of students required. Each school does need at least five registered students in order to receive trophies.

Is there a limit to the number of students my school can bring to the Mini-Mu?

• No, you may bring as many students as you would like.

Can my school send students who are not taking 6th or 7th grade math?

No.

Can students who are not from my school join our group?

No.

Can parents register their child separate from our school group?

• No. Each student must be registered by their school in order to participate.

Are parents required to stay for the entire contest?

No. We would like at least one <u>sponsor</u> from each school to be on campus.

I already sent in my registration. Can I add students?

Yes. You may add students as late as Saturday morning but this may cause seating issues since your group has been assigned a certain number of seats. Also, adding students is fine but you may not substitute students. If John Smith has decided not to come but Mary Jones is coming then we will be glad to arrange for Mary to participate but that will require that the \$10.00 registration for Mary be paid.
