New: 2010 calculations of Learning Gains include Florida Alternate Assessment results.

NOTE: If a school otherwise graded "C" or "B" does not demonstrate adequate progress for reading and math for two years in a row, the final grade may be reduced by one letter grade.

NEW High school grading includes 50% of FCAT Components and 50% on New High School Components including Graduation, Acceleration, Readiness and Growth/Decline.

New High School Grading
Graduation Rate- 4 year cohort-based on N.G.A.
At-Risk - Students who score Level 1 & 2 on Reading and Math on Grade 8 FCAT
Accelerated Coursework -AP, IB, AICE, Dual Enrollment, and Industry Certification.
Post Secondary Readiness- SAT, ACT, and CPT
