PEP Scholarship Family Guide



WHAT IS A SCHOOL CHOICE SCHOLARSHIP?

Florida's School Choice Scholarships give families the flexibility to use public education funds for schools and services that best meet their child's needs. House Bill 1 (HB 1) now requires **all scholarship recipients** to use these funds to cover the cost of Leon County Virtual School (LCVS) courses.

FAQs

Who is eligible for LCVS as a scholarship recipient?



All Florida students are eligible. Families use PEP funds to enroll in individual courses at LCVS.

Why do I have to pay for courses now?

All Florida students are eligible. Families use PEP funds to enroll in individual courses at LCVS.

Why did I recieve an invoice for a course already in progress?

If your child was actively enrolled in a course when the scholarship became effective, the tuition applies even if the course began earlier.

Course fees are non-refundable, including in cases of withdrawal.

Enrollment and Payment Guidlines

Enrollment:

- Students must enroll as "Private School" student type during the LCVS admissions process.
- PEP (Personalized Education Program) scholarship recipients must use scholarship funds to pay for courses.
- Funds mush be available in scholarship account.

USING SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS IN THE EMA PORTAL

- 1. Log in to the **EMA Portal**.
- 2. Click "Marketplace".
- 3. Click "Find Providers".
- 4. Select your student from the drop-down menu.
- 5. Under Service Category, choose Leon County School District.
- 6. Click "Search" and choose Leon County Virtual School.
- 7. Select the number of segments or full-year courses.
- 8. Click "Add to Cart" then "Go to Cart".
- 9. Complete the checkout process by selecting "Reserve Funds".

Course Tuition:

- .\$350 per half-credit course (one semester/segment).
- Charges apply to any course enrolled in or registered for as of the scholarship's effective date, even if the course started before.
- Refunds are not issued
