About Pre-K ESE

Pre-K ESE serves children three through five years of age who have special needs. Classes are located within Leon County (LCS) elementary schools and community-based sites. Students in this program must meet eligibility requirements.



Eligibility

Eligible students qualify by meeting the criteria for a disability under IDEA. If the student doesn't already have an Individual Education Plan (IEP) one will be created for them through the Pre-K Screening/Evaluation process. The IEP is updated at least once annually.
