Keeping Our Room Clean

I will be taking steps each day to help keep our classroom clean and safe. I will disinfect surfaces throughout the day. Please let me know if you have any concerns.





Masks

- Masks reduce the spread of germs. Due to distance limitations masks will be worn at all times in the classroom by students and teachers.
- We will talk about keeping our hands off our masks and only removing them when instructed to do so. We will take a mask break outside every 90 minutes.
- Please help me by making sure to send a clean mask each day.
- Please have your child store an extra mask in a labeled Ziploc in their backpack.



Staying Healthy

- Your child will have their temperature taken each day as they enter the school.
- Students will wash their hands upon entering the classroom and routinely throughout the day.
- Students must be fever-free for 72 hours before returning to school.
- If your child is tested for COVID-19, the student must bring physician approval for return to school.



Outside of Our Classroom

- Masks will be worn during all transitions outside of the class.
- Children will be seated 6 feet apart in the cafeteria.
- Only one first grade class will have recess at a time. Playgrounds will be sanitized throughout the day.
- Students will wear masks at recess if they are unable to keep proper distancing.



New School Guidelines

- Visitors and volunteers will not be allowed on campus during the first semester. This includes walking students to class, eating lunch with students, or volunteering in the classroom.
- Please wear a mask into the front office when signing your child out for an appointment.
- Breakfast and a bagged lunch will be free for all students.
- Water fountains will not be used. Please send your child with a water bottle.



Birthday Celebrations

- We are excited to celebrate your child's birthday!
- New school-wide policy: We will not be allowing outside treats, trinkets, goodie bags, etc. to be passed out this school year.
- Teachers will recognize and celebrate your child in a special way.
