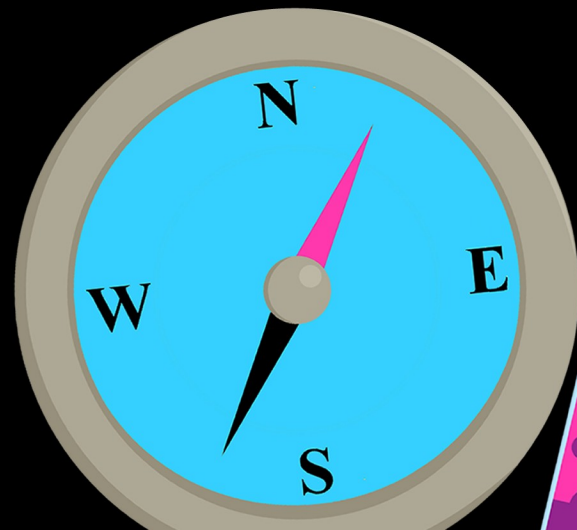
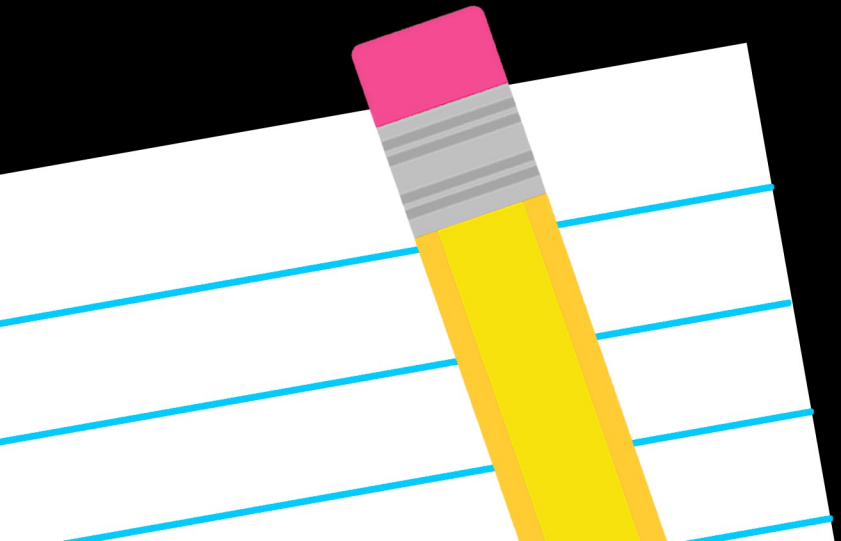


# Classroom Procedures

**If a student is LATE to school:**

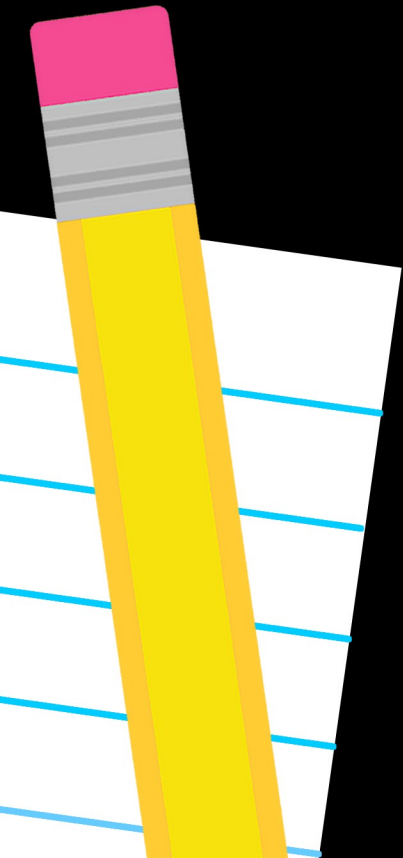

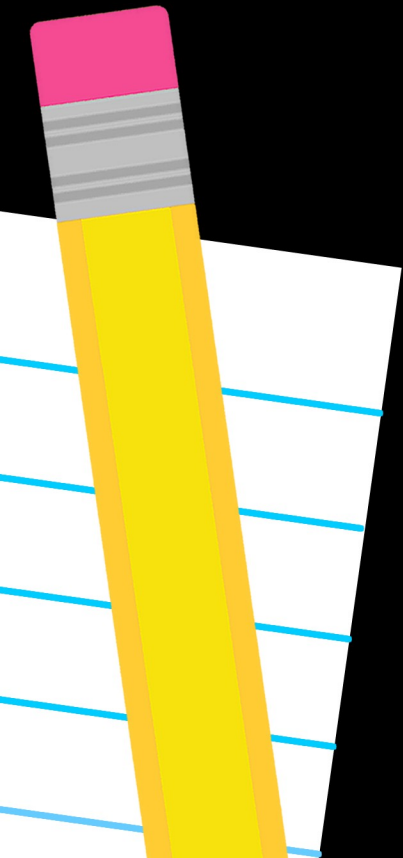

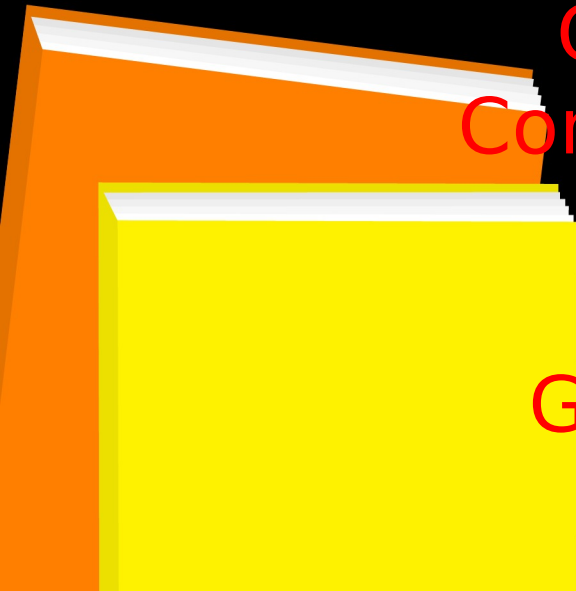

# Spelling

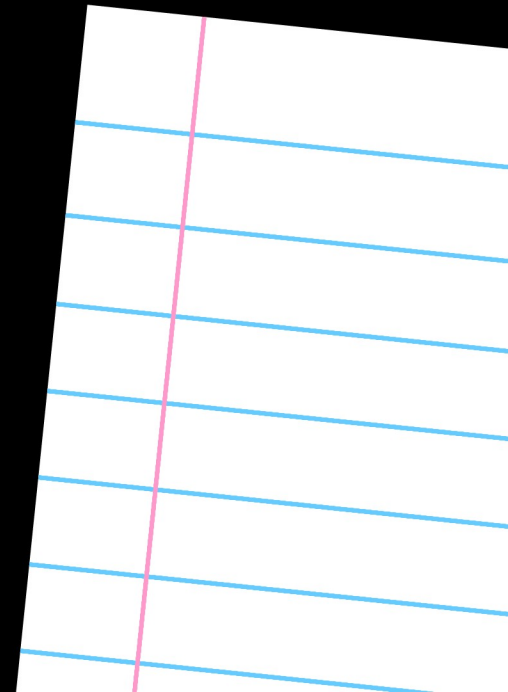
- Spelling words are located on the “Weekly Outline” sheet that comes home in your child’s DOT folder.

# Writer's Workshop


Writing skills we will be working on throughout the year:
