- We have two children, Addison, attending 2nd grade here at KLES, and Alexander who is 15 months.



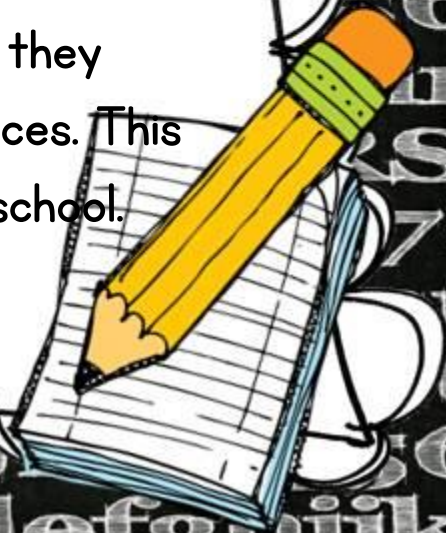
Classroom EXPECTATIONS

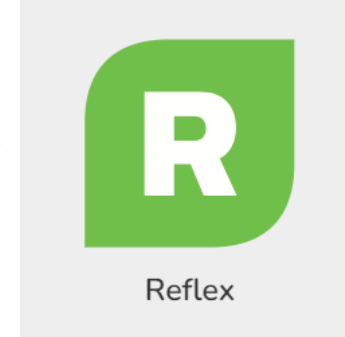

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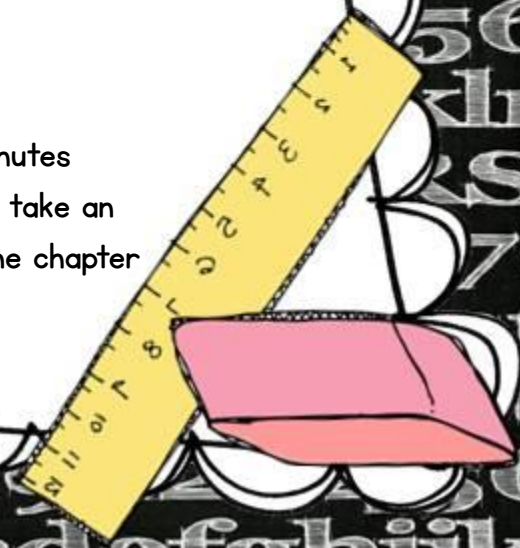
Reading passages will be sent home on Friday and will be due back the following Friday.



Math Facts should be practiced 3-4 times per week either through Reflex Math or flash cards. Check the Go Math Outline sent home in the Weekly Parent Email to review skills for each chapter. Prior to each test, a review sheet will come home.



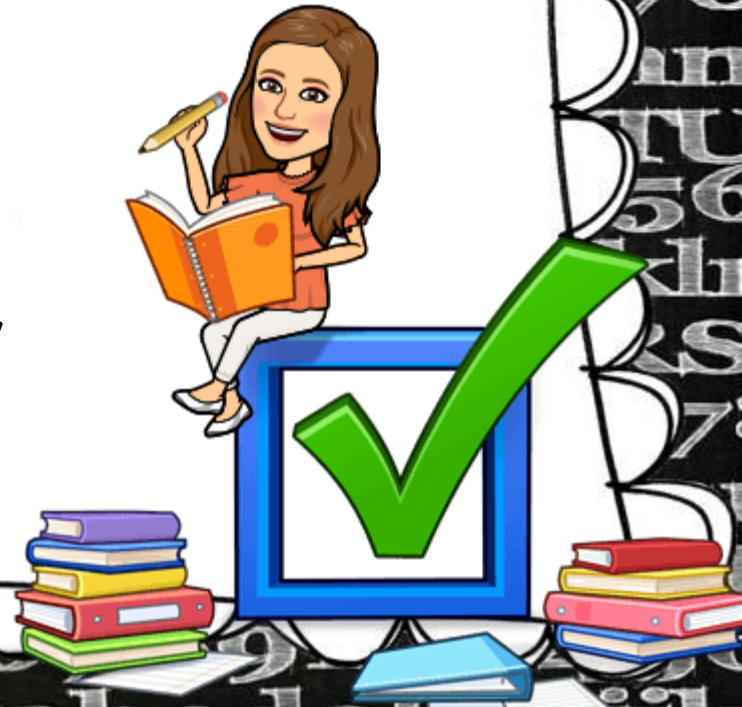
Your child should read for a minimum of 15-20 minutes each night. Each week, your child should read and take an AR test on a minimum of two picture books or one chapter book. AR tests should not be taken at home.



Our HOMEWORK

Spelling is practiced and reviewed on an “as needed” basis. I suggest giving a practice test at home at the start of the week. If your child knows the words already, no need to study the ones they got right.

If homework is fully completed and turned in, they will receive 100% credit. Homework counts for their Work/Study grade (E,S,N).

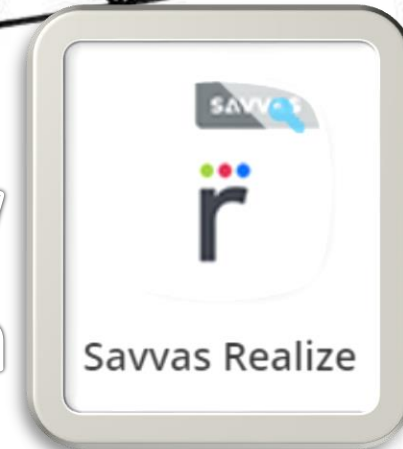
ELA Standards

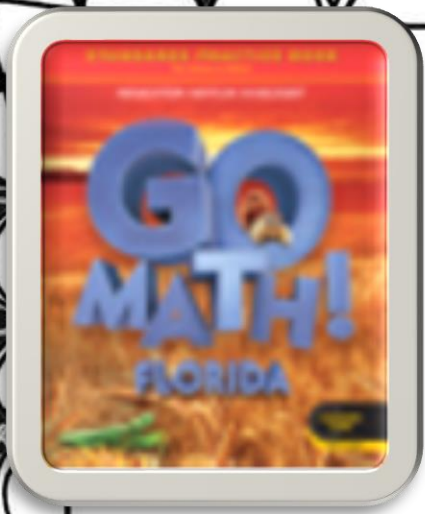

LANGUAGE ARTS Assessments

Spelling: Spelling words are sent home on the green MyView outline sheet in your child's yellow folder each week. Please practice the words with your child. Our spelling checks will be each Friday.

Vocabulary: Vocabulary words are introduced and assessed every week. Words and definitions are sent home on the MyView outline in your child's folder.

Assessments: Students will be assessed each week on the skills covered in our Language Arts curriculum. The assessment will include a story with five questions, vocabulary, and a phonics skill. This is an independent reading assessment. There are no retests on assessments because skills are spiraled throughout the year.

Assessments

Math: Mid-Chapter Checkpoints will be given as quizzes throughout the chapter. Chapter tests are given at the end of the chapter.

Students will only be able to retest if they scored below a 70%. Both tests will be averaged; however, the maximum grade will be 70%.

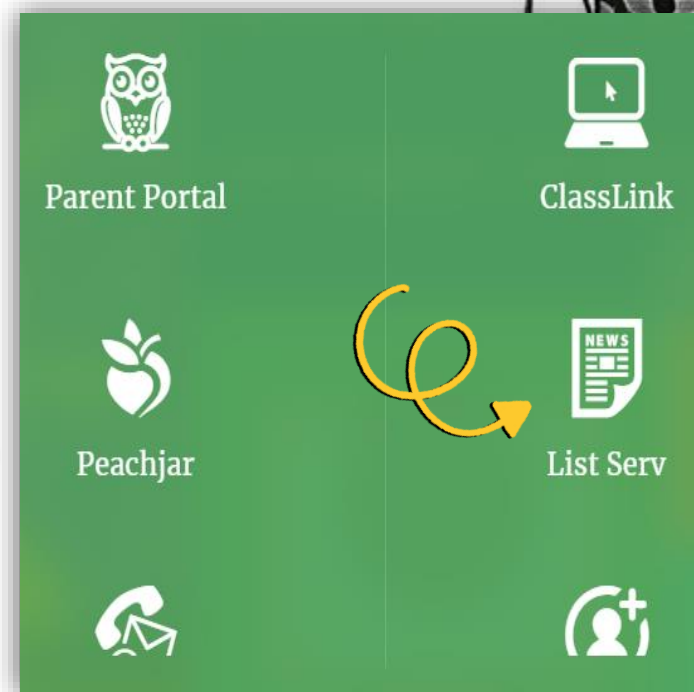
