Students are expected to follow the KLES school rules. Be Respectful, Be Responsible, Be Ready to Learn


Behavior & Work/Study shamrocks are coded daily, if need be. Parents should initial each night and students return them each morning.




Reading passages will be sent home on Friday and will be due back the following Friday.





A Math practice sheet will sometimes be stapled to the reading passage sheet. Math Facts should be practiced 3-4 times per week either through Reflex Math or flash cards. Check the Go Math Outline sent home in the Weekly Parent Email to review skills for each chapter. Prior to each test, a review sheet will come home.



Our HOMEWORK

Phonics is practiced and reviewed on a weekly basis. Use the Home Practice half sheets to review reading and spelling of new concepts, irregular words, and sentence writing.

If homework is fully completed and turned in, they will receive 100% credit. Homework counts for their Work/Study grade (E,S,N).

LANGUAGE ARTS Assessments

Phonics: Phonics skill practice sheets are sent home on green half sheets in your child's yellow folder each week. Please practice the skills with your child. Our UFLI checks will be each Friday.

Yocabulary: Vocabulary words are introduced and assessed every week. Words and definitions are sent home on the Week at a Glance outline in your child's folder.

<u>Assessments</u>: Students will be assessed each week on the skills covered in our Language Arts curriculum. The assessment will include I story with ten questions, vocabulary, and phonics skill. This is an independent reading assessment. There are no retests on assessments because skills are spiraled throughout the year.

MATH Assessments

Mouth: Mid-Chapter Checkpoints will be given as quizzes throughout the chapter. Chapter tests are given at the end of the chapter. *Note: Some chapters do not have a mid-chapter.

Students will only be able to retest if they scored below a 70%. Both tests will be averaged; however, the maximum grade will be 70%.




