MORNING PROCEDURES Students will go to their classrooms

for the first three days of school. The school day begins at 8:25am. Morning supervision will begin at 7:45am in the cafeteria. At 8:05am, students will be dismissed to go to the primary playground. Children should place their backpacks where their teachers name is written on a sign in the primary covered area, before playing on the playground each day. This is where the children are to line up when the bell rings at 8:25am. Teachers will meet classes under the primary covered area at the first bell. Upon entry, students will wash hands and work on early morning activities until the bell rings.

DISMISSAL PROCEDURES We dismiss our car and gate students at 2:50. Car pick up parents, please hang the car tag on the rearview mirror to help expedite the pick up process. Any changes that affect how your child goes home please send a note in the Daily Folder stating the changes or call the school prior to 2:30. Emails sent during the school day may not be seen until after school. We are not permitted to change how a child normally goes home without written consent or a phone call from you. This is to ensure the safety of all of our students.

SNACK Please send in a daily snack to help fuel your child for a rigorous day. Cheese and crackers, fruit, pretzels, yogurt, and granola bars are a few of the nutritious snacks you might send. School policy prohibits candy and soda drinks. Your child may keep a bottle of water on their desk. PLEASE **don't freeze** the bottle...this causes a mess when the condensation leaves water on the desk. No flavored water or juice. Plain water is healthiest.

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DAILY FOLDERS Important papers, newsletters, graded work, and homework assignments will come home in your child's daily folder. Not only will this folder help build responsibility, it will also help facilitate the lines of communication between home and school. This is a communication folder that will come home every day. It is important for parents to check this folder daily.

Please send any money in an envelope and write what the money is for on the front.
