

# Board blank? - Share your display set up

## The short cut:

press the windows key and “p” at the same time.


The windows key is generally located on the bottom row of keys and looks like the Microsoft Windows logo. You will have a menu pop up.

Click on duplicate

Click on start menu -> Settings -> System

It will open to Display settings. Scroll down to Multiple displays, click on dropbox under Multiple Displays, then click duplicate to share your screen. You should now see your display on board.
