Hello students and parents! By the end of the week, students should be able to:

ELA- Create a writing plan to explain about a given topic. Write an introductory paragraph. Sentences should be complete and neatly written.

Identify Words and phrases in poems and songs that use rhyme and regular beats. Describe how this language builds meaning and rhythm. Participate as a presenter or part of the audience during our Shape-Bot share at 10 AM (T, W, Th)

Math- Identify and create equal shares of a group, solve problems involving time intervals (hour before and hour after), practice elapsed time in hours and minutes, estimate using non-standard units and describe measurement data on a line plot.

Science- (Science: The Human Body) – distinguish human body parts (brain, heart, lungs, stomach, muscles, and skeleton) their locations, and their basic functions; name healthy options to health-related issues and problems; and investigate and explain findings.
