## Math:

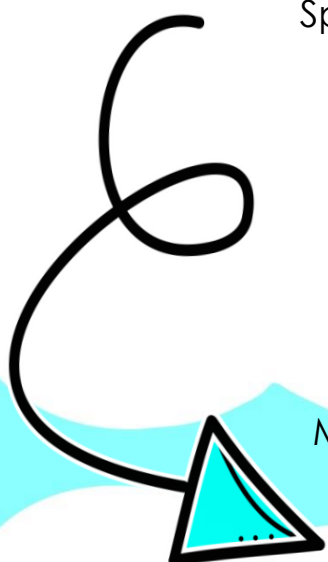
Mid-Chapter Checkpoints will be given as quizzes throughout the chapter. Chapter tests are given at the end of the chapter.

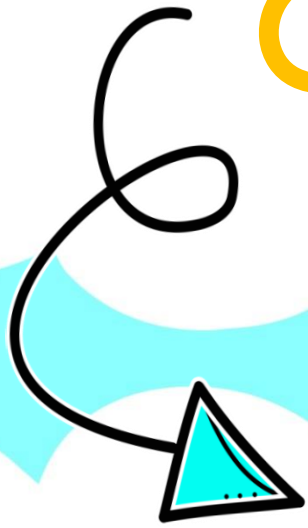
# Accelerated READER

AR is our Reading Incentive program that helps to encourage independent reading and helps foster reading comprehension.

Goals and reading levels are given at the beginning of each 9 weeks. It is the student's responsibility to track their independent goals and pace their reading to achieve them. Parents are able to monitor their child's progress by visiting their Renaissance account through Classlink. Students are encouraged to read at least 20 minutes night.

There will be an A.R. celebration each 9 weeks for those students who reach their goals.
