### Apply Online.

Complete the Leon County Schools Volunteer/Mentor application at: <u>volunteers.leonschools.net</u> Then, sign up for Mentor Training at: <u>leonschools.net/**mentor**</u>

#### Attend Training.

Next, attend Mentor training at Leon County Schools' District Office. Training sessions typically last for one hour.

#### Submit Fingerprints.

Leon County Schools requires fingerprinting and a criminal background check for all Mentor applicants. There is no cost to the applicant for this service.

#### Meet Mentee.

Once training is complete and everything is processed and approved, the applicant is officially cleared as a Leon County Schools Mentor. **Congratulations!**
