

Want to Enroll Your Child In Pre-K?



Qualifiers for Leon County Schools Early Childhood Programs Pre-Kindergarten:

- Child must be 4 yrs. on or before September 1
- Child is 3 yrs. and has a developmental delay that can be documented
- Must be a Leon County resident

Enrollment is based on a first come - first served basis.



Step 1

If your child qualifies, you will need to call the Early Childhood Programs Office to set up an Screening appointment. Only a parent or Legal Guardian (with proof of guardianship) can complete the process.



Step 2

At your Screening appointment you will need to bring the following or else the child cannot be seen:

- Child's birth certificate
- Proof of residence - Two forms that meet Leon County Schools policy requirements (Refer to leonschools.net)
- Parent photo identification
- The child and parent must both be in attendance at all times.

IMPORTANT: If you are late for your appointment, you will have to reschedule.



Step 3

After your Screening and/or Evaluation appointment(s) you will be contacted to arrange a Close-Out meeting (usually around 45-60 days from your last appointment.) This is when you will receive the information you need to enroll your child in a Leon County School.
