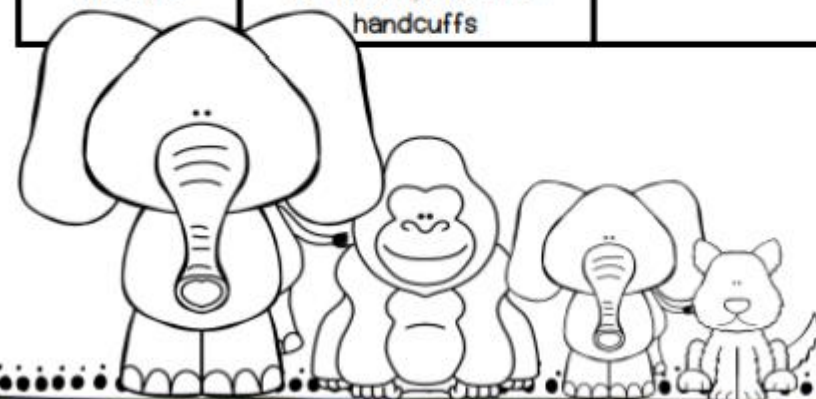

shackles	Chains used to keep hands or feet together, like handcuffs	



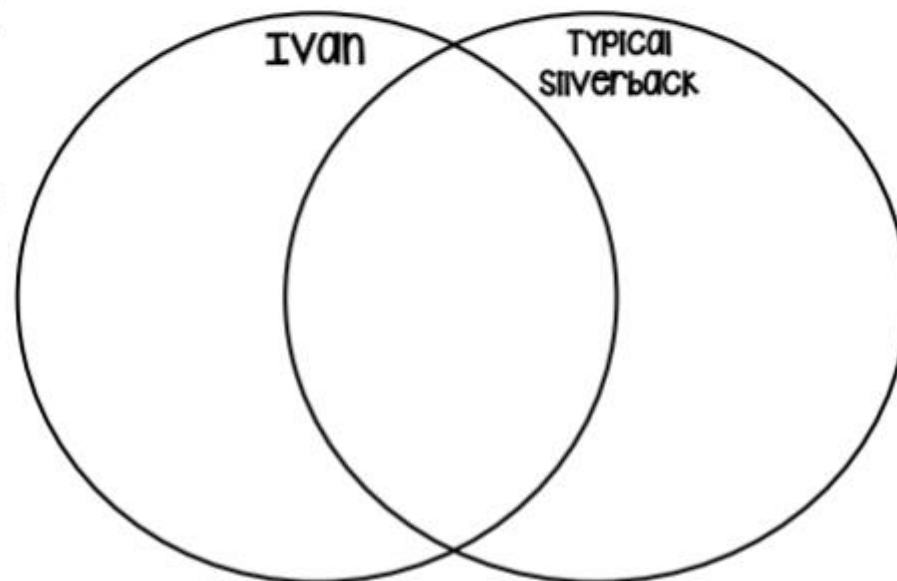
