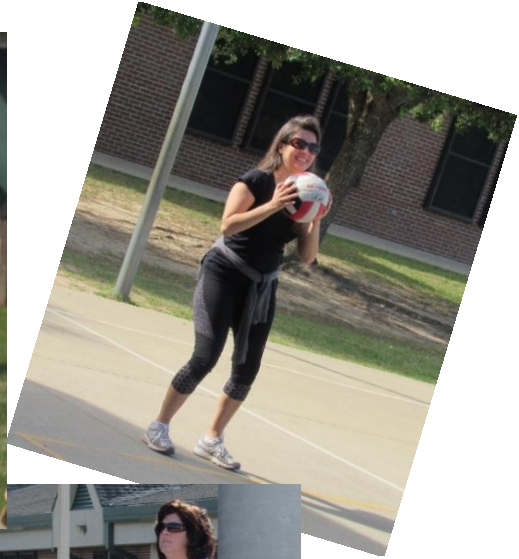
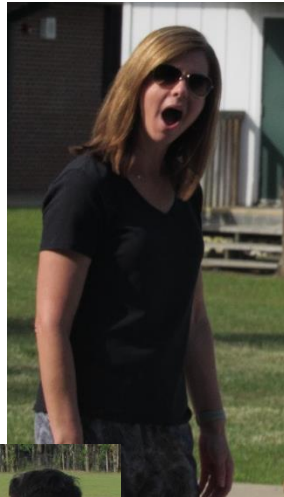

5th Grade Memories

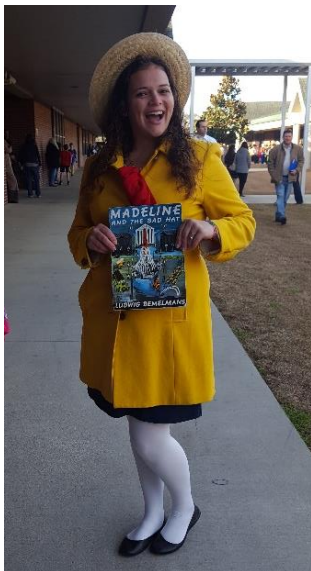
We asked some of our fifth grade friends to tell us their favorite memory of their time at Roberts.

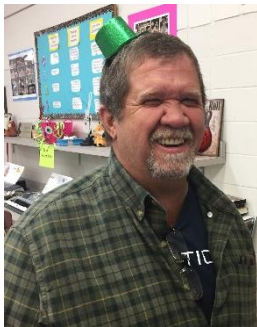
- * Savana Pittman – In 4th grade I walked in on Mrs. Blackburn dancing on the desk to music with the other kids. (LOL)
