We have tried to make it so that you shouldn't need to buy any materials, but we want to provide this list to you in case there are things you need to make sure you have access to.

You will only need materials for 4 of the activities, and many can be reused!

Activity 1:

- A clear jar/container with a lid
- Tea
- Gold water

Activity 2:

- Multiple bouncy balls of different sizes
 - Baseballs, basketballs, soccer balls, etc. work!

Activity 3:

- A bouncy ball

Activity 4:

- Plastic bottle filled with water
- Wax paper

Activity 5:

- Cup
- Penny
- Index card

Activity 6:

- Three books
- Penny
- Toy car
- Something to act as a ramp
- BONUS: balloon and car

Activity 7:

- Several coins of the same type
 - All pennies, quarters, dimes, etc.
- A butter knife (plastic takeout ones work great for this!)

Activity 8:

- Tape
- Rubber Bands
- Metal container with lid (will be destroyed in the process)
- Screwdriver
- 9-Volt battery
- Paperclips

The lab activities and questions will be posted on Monday, May 11th and you will have 2 weeks to complete the activities. One of the options you choose will be input as an assessment grade.
