About Pre-K ESE

Pre-K ESE serves children three through five years of age who have special needs. Classes are located within Leon County (LCS) elementary schools and communitybased sites. Students in this program must meet eligibility requirements set by LCS Special Programs and Procedures.

Eligibility

1.0

Students must demonstrate a developmental delay, or physical/mental disability to receive ESE services. If the student doesn't already have an Individual Education Plan (IEP) one will be created for them through the Pre-K Screening/Evaluation process. The IEP is updated each year the child maintains ESE services with LCS.

- Behavior Therapy
- Physical Therapy
- Assistive Technology
- Adaptive Physical Education
