



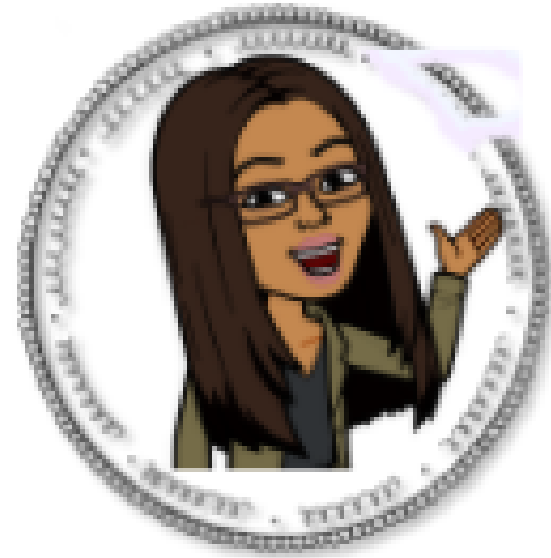

Expectations

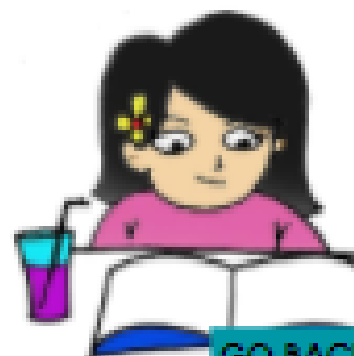
Canvas and the world of digital learning is new to many of us. In order for us to not feel overwhelmed by it all, let's show compassion and grace, not only to others but to ourselves.

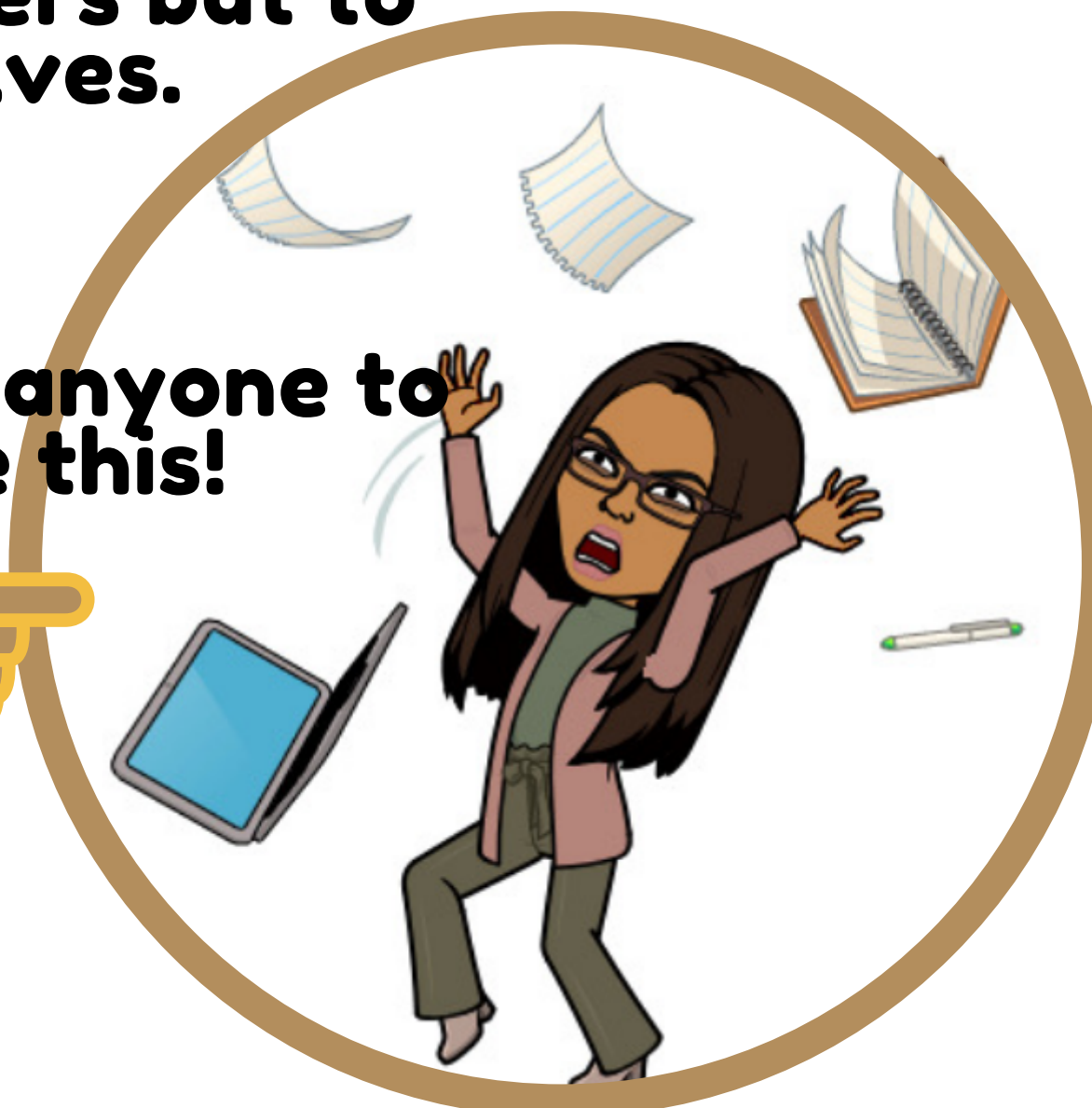
Be Positive: We are charting new territory, I ask that we just be patient and compassionate with one another as we journey down this Digital Academy path to ensure our scholar has success in second grade.

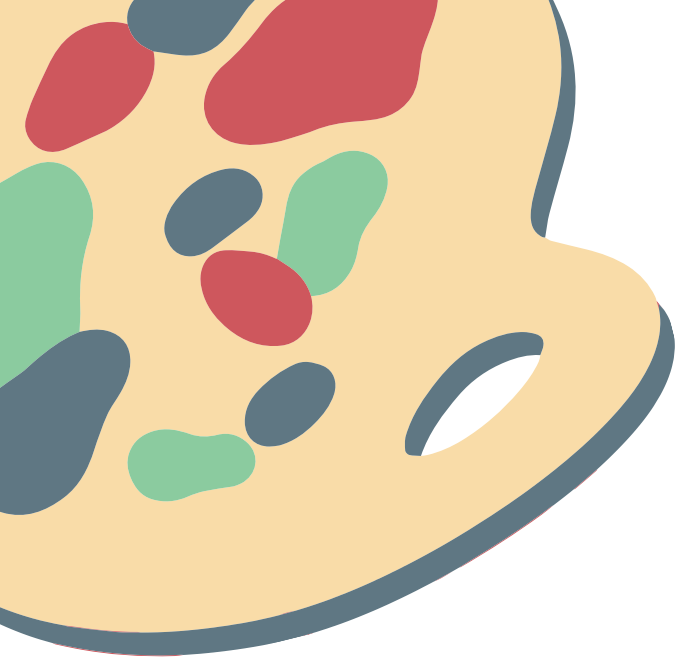
Be Productive: We may be learning from home, but my expectations are the same. Scholars and parents are required to give their best effort, 100% of the time to maximize learning gains.



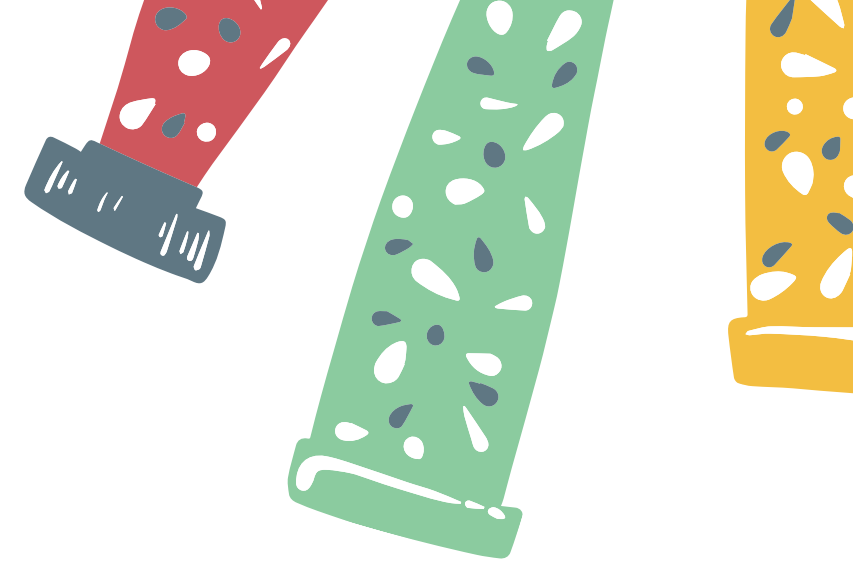


RULES for ZOOM Meeting





Be on time!
