Dear Parents,

We are releasing information about SAIL's version of the LCS #850 Program via this communication. SAIL will host our own #850 Summer Recovery Program. This program is by invitation only.

Students who failed a Semester 1 course will be given written notices to attend. Students who are in danger of failing semester 2 will also be given personalized written notices of classes that they need to pass in order to not have to attend. Letters will be distributed tomorrow during 2nd period. Please ask your student if they received a letter. Students who failed Semester 1 will also have their letter mailed home today. It may take some time for it to arrive.

As an added measure of checks and balances, please check the parent portal and see if your student failed Semester 1. If your student failed the semester of a course, we would like to assist your student in staying on track for graduation. They will be given an opportunity to recover their missed credits as part of the LCS #850 program. This recovery will take place this summer here at SAIL, both digitally and face to face utilizing PLATO credit recovery curriculum. Students are expected to attend and work consistently just as if it were the regular school year. Behavior problems will not be tolerated and the student will be asked to go home should problems arise. Students who are wasting time and are not on task will also be asked to go home.
