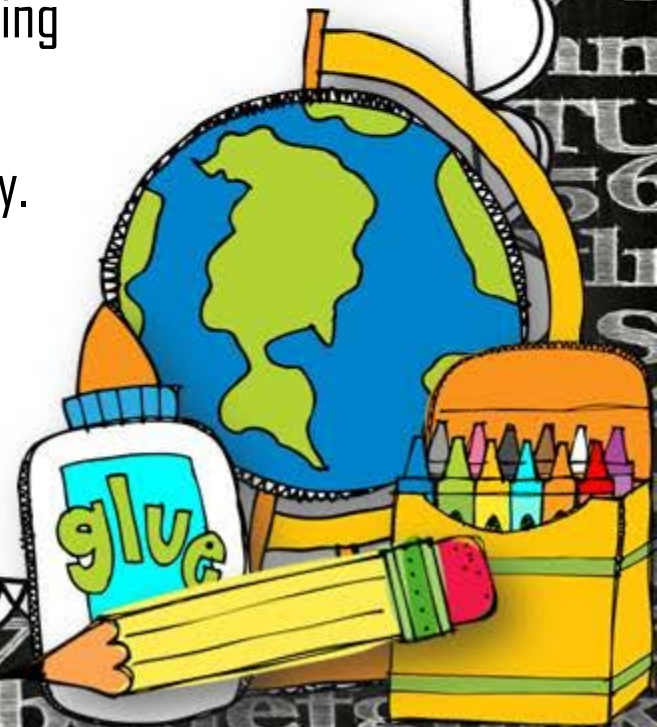

# Homework Policy

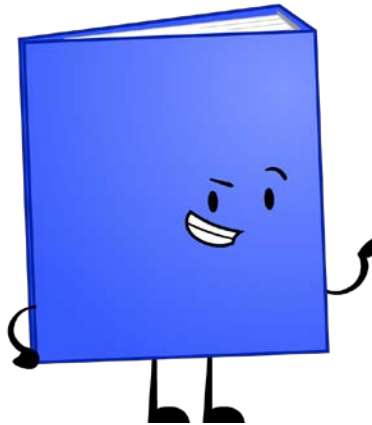
- All students will have nightly reading. Students should be reading at least 30 minutes.
- Math homework will come home daily (except for Friday) and will be reviewed in class the following day.
- Science/Reading will come home sporadically.







# Organization




- Each student should have a 2 inch binder.
- Binders travel to and from school and classes each day.
- Students are responsible for keeping supplies in their binder/zipper pouch.
- HW and class specific work should go into its corresponding folder.

**RED = ELA/SS**

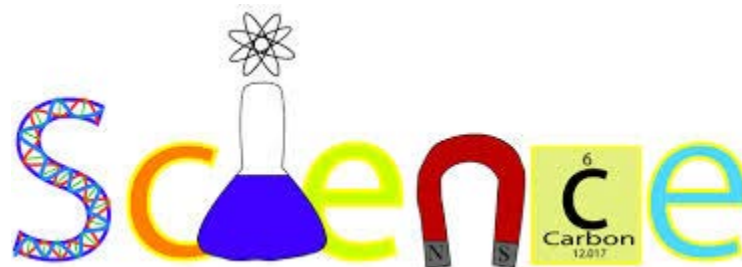
**BLUE = MATH**

**GREEN = SCIENCE**

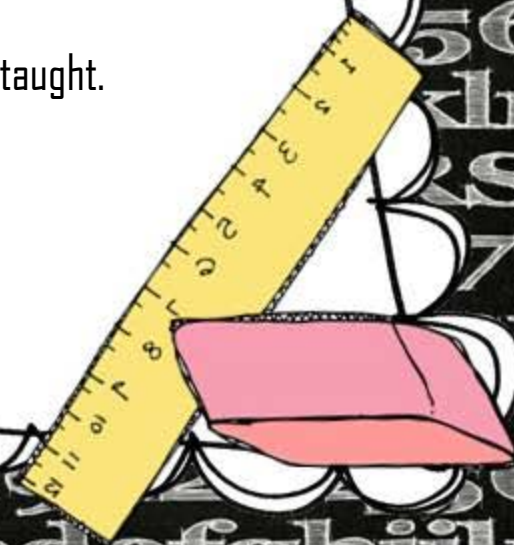

# Quarantined?

Your child can access all of their textbooks on their Class Link and can keep up with the class. *There will be no live Zooms*, and we ask that your child complete missed work on notebook paper (or they may print it) and bring it back with them the day they return.







# Social Studies

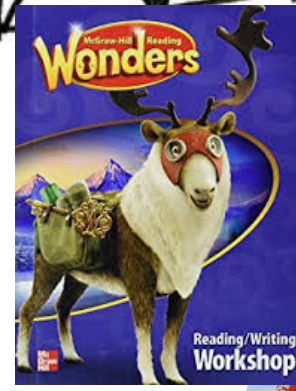


- We use Florida Virtual School Social Studies curriculum to provide guided and independent instruction.

- Project assignments will be sent home with students & via email.

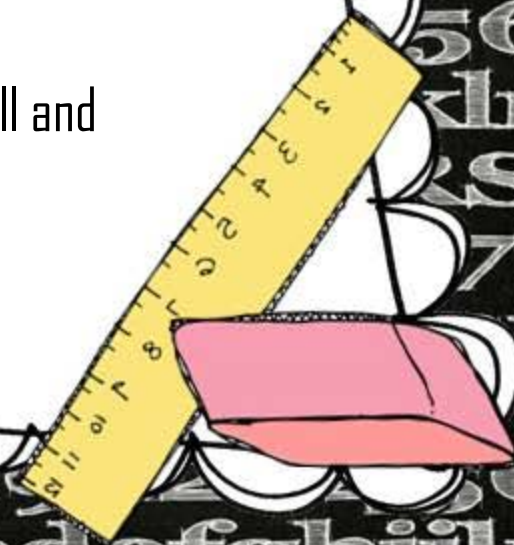




# ELA
