2020-2021 KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

If you have a little one who will start kindergarten in August of 2020, you will be able to register your child in Focus starting March 24, 2020. Parents, go to the Leon County Schools website homepage, click on the A+ icon at the top of the page and follow directions for registration. You will need 5 things to enroll your child for kindergarten:

- 1. Mortgage, property tax statement or lease
- 2. Additional proof (utility bill, driver's license),
- 3. Birth Certificate
- 4. Immunization record
- 5. Current school physical (dated after 8/1/2019).

Our 2020-2021 Kindergarten Parent meeting will take place on Tuesday, April 7, at 6:00 pm, and the Kindergarten Orientation & Tour will be on Thursday, April 30, 2020, at 9:30 am.
