

- AR Reading 20 mins. daily
- Study Spelling Words- Test every other Thursday
 *Spelling City has our words uploaded for digital practice. Access on ClassLink
- Vocab. Packet (Goes home Friday and due the following Friday) Students are encouraged to work together on this at the end of each day

ACCELERATED READER
•AR book comes home daily and should be read 20 minutes and returned to school the next day
•AR tests CAN be taken at home.
•Parents receive weekly AR updates on Fridays in the binder please initial the paper each week
•Parents can sign up for Home Connect for automatic updates
•Students are expected to reach AR Goals: 88% comprehension & 100% of point goal

HOW CAN I AS A PARENT HELP WITH AR?

- Read to and with your child... they aren't too old for this!
- Ask your child what they are reading.
- Set page goals for accountability
- Set aside 20 minutes for AR daily. Set a timer if needed

 If your child has trouble staying focused, purchase a whisper phone to use or let them record themselves reading.






- Study Social Weekly articles for Tests

- Test dates in planner and on weekly newsletter







