ACTION REQUESTED: The Superintendent recommends Board approval of RFQ 510-2023, Nims Middle School Cafeteria Replacement and Gym Renovation Project, to Fitzgerald Collaborative Group, LLC as the highest ranked firm by the Selection Committee in accordance with Chapter 287.055, Florida Statutes. Approval of this Agenda Item grants authorization to negotiate with the next-highest ranked firm, should negotiations fail with Fitzgerald Collaborative Group, LLC. Once negotiations have been finalized, the contract will be submitted to the Board for approval.

ITEM SUMMARY: The committee for the recommendation of architects convened on May 9, 2023, to interview architectural firms for Nims Middle School, New Construction of a New Cafeteria with Stage/Multipurpose Dining Area, Demolition of Existing Cafeteria, New Construction, Remodeling and Renovations to Gymnasium and Site Work. Nine(9) firms submitted qualification statements for this project, of which five (5) were selected to interview. The committee ranked the firms as follows:

- 1. Fitzgerald Collaborative Group, LLC
- 2. Architects Lewis+Whitlock, PA
- 3. MLD Architects. LLC
- 4. Hov+Stark Architects, P.A.
- 5. Altman+Barrett Architects, PC

The total estimated construction budget for this Project is \$7,975,000.

The recommended construction delivery method for this project is Construction Management. Major tasks are defined, but there is potential for unknown conditions, and the need to work around the school's schedule. The type of work is not unique, but the coordination and timing of all the required trades is complicated. District staffing is insufficient to provide the type of supervision needed on this project during the busy summer construction session.

Fitzgerald Collaborative Group has earned \$627,026 in Leon County School Board projects over the last 3 years.

This will be a phased project.
