ACTION REQUESTED: The Superintendent recommends approval of the Selection Committee's recommendation of award for Request for Qualifications (RFQ) 512-2023 for Construction Management Services for the Leon High School Building 7 Remodel, Renovation, and Roofing Project to RAM Construction & Development, LLC. and authorizes contract negotiations. RAM Construction and Development is the highest-ranked firm for this project, in accordance with Chapter 255, Florida Statutes. Should negotiations with RAM Construction & Development, LLC. fail, approval of this agenda item authorizes the Superintendent to negotiate with the next highest-ranked firm. Once negotiations have been finalized and contract documents are complete, the Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) contract will be submitted to the Board for approval.

ITEM SUMMARY: The Selection Committee for RFQ 512-2023 convened on April 5, 2023, to interview construction management firms for the Leon High School, Building 7, Remodeling and Renovations and Roof Project. Four (4) firms submitted qualification statements for this project, of which all four (4) were selected to interview.

The committee ranked the firms as follows:

- 1. RAM Construction & Development, LLC
- 2. Childers Construction Co.
- 3. Cook Brothers, Inc.
- 4. Rippee Construction, Inc.

The estimated construction budget for Leon High School, Building 7, Remodeling and Renovations and Roof Project is \$6,400,000.00.

The recommended construction delivery method for this project is Construction Management. Major tasks are defined, but there is potential for unknown conditions, and the need to work around the school's schedule. The type of work is not unique, but the coordination and timing of all the required trades is complicated. District staffing is insufficient to provide the type of supervision needed on this project during the busy summer construction session.

RAM Construction & Development, LLC has earned \$6,067,296.88 in Leon County School Board projects over the last 3 years.

This is not a phased project.
