- Oversee the content development and updating of social media for program promotion and awareness (web Page, Facebook, etc)

- Arrange lodging accommodations for technician training
- Arrange transportation for technicians attending training sessions
- Ensure lodging, meals and transportation reimbursement for instructors and technicians is properly handled
- Coordinate with Lively Technical College to ensure training fees are accurate and paid
- Provide needed training and presentations as needed and required
- Make contact with transit agencies and other organizations and entities state wide to promote and increase awareness of the LPIP training
- Evaluate available paratransit agency audit information to determine needed training and instruction
- Share industry issues and recommend positive changes relative to paratransit maintenance statewide
- Coordinate with FDOT relative to legislative para transit vehicle standards, changes and revisions
- Submit any needed documentation to the FDOT
