










Once your forms are submitted, you will receive an invitation to sign up for your kindergarten screening (7/12, 8:30-4:45).

Helpful Information

Label Items:

Please write your child's name, with a permanent marker, on their backpack, pencil box, scissors, lunch box, and any jackets. The rest of the supply items do not need to be labeled.

Clothing:

Kindergarten children are very active, so please dress your child in comfortable clothes that they are allowed to get dirty. No flip flops, sandals or slides. We do ask that you send in a change of clothes, in a labeled Ziploc bag, to keep at school in case of an accident.
