themselves and their respective leadership role. They shared information from each high school including breast cancer awareness/fundraisers, homecoming festivities and other student led events.

Information about the 2nd Annual Longest Table was shared with DAC. This event will occur at Lawton Chilies High School and involve all area high schools (public and private). Students will share a meal and get to learn about each other during this event. Last year's event was very successful and the student leaders are planning for another successful event.

New Member Orientation: VIII.

Dr. Gayle welcomed all DAC members and thanked them for their support of LCS. She mentioned that the Superintendent and Board members admire and appreciate the service of this esteemed group of leaders. She asked DAC members to ensure they attend meetings and become involved in the processes that help to our District become stronger. The role of each DAC member includes attending meetings, staying engaged during each meeting and sharing information with his/her School Advisory Council after each DAC meeting. Dr. Gayle also showed members where DAC information is housed on the District website.

LCS Safety and Security: IX.

Presentation by Chief Jimmy Williams regarding safety and security in Leon County Schools. He spoke about hurricane preparedness, additional deputies at our high schools, the new Zero Eyes cameras, and the Pup Patrol for gun detection. He reminded members about the new protocol during football games and how the fans are appreciative of these safety efforts.

DAC members were reminded about calling 922-KIDS should they need to report any safety concerns.

Chief Williams also shared that we are asking about replenishing the Stop the Bleed Kits. DOE has \$250,000 for kits for the entire state.

Questions were asked about access control gates. We have six of them in the District. The cost is \$45,000 per school for these gates.

STAR Metro: X.

Kathryn Frizzell (STAR Metro) reminded members that all students ride STAR Metro at no cost. However, students must have a STAR Metro ID card. If a student does not have a card the cost is .60. There were 2300 student cards distributed during the 2022/2023 school year. LCS Safety and Security made 1800 of these cards and STAR Metro did the rest. Seventy percent of the students who have STAR Metro cards have been using them. There have been approximately 4200 student trips per month using STAR Metro cards.

XI. **Textbook Adoption:**

Assistant Superintendent Shane Syfrett shared a detailed flyer about the Instructional Materials Adoption Process (see attached). LCS only uses martials from the state adoption list. The review
