



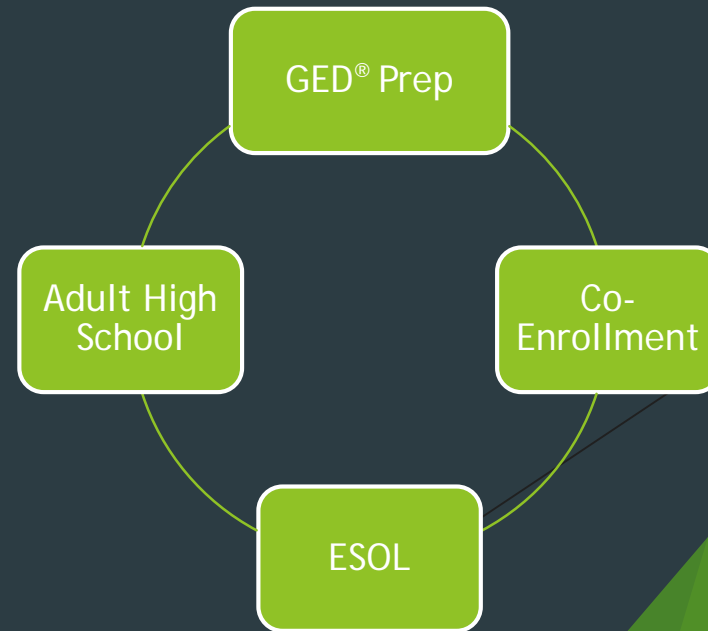

We offer GED® Prep classes to help adult students prepare to earn their high school diploma, English classes for speakers of other languages, high school credit classes for high school students who need to make up a credit as well as high school credit classes for adult students who need a few credits to graduate. ACE is “A Great Start for a Better Future” and a stepping stone to post-secondary education, the workforce or military.



Adult High School & Co-Enrollment

- ▶ Small classes
- ▶ One-on-one tutoring with a certified teacher
- ▶ Main goal is to assist students that are credit deficient
- ▶ Provides both a teacher and an online curriculum
- ▶ Self-paced
- ▶ Open enrollment



ADULT HIGH SCHOOL VS CO ENROLLMENT

- ▶ Adult High School- Adults no longer enrolled in high school who need a few credits to earn a High School Diploma.
- ▶ AHS- Classes are self paced.
- ▶ AHS- Classes offered on ACE Main Campus 1:00-5:00 Monday- Thursday
- ▶ Co-Enrollment- Any Public or Private High School student who needs to improve a D or F in a core class.
- ▶ Co-Enrollment- Students must obtain the co enrollment form from their guidance counselor

GED[®] Prep Classes

- ▶ Students age 16 and older
- ▶ Students must be withdrawn from K-12 school
- ▶ Small classes
- ▶ All levels of students, based on initial assessment
- ▶ Orientation Tuesday-Thursday each week
 - ▶ Complete online orientation and registration at www.aceleon.org
 - ▶ Come to campus the following week to complete enrollment. This is a 2-day process that begins on Tuesdays and finishes on Thursdays (each day is 3 hours long). There are different sessions 8:15, 12:15, or 5:15 in which you can choose to attend for the 2-day in person process.
- ▶ Classes offered in the morning, afternoon, evening, and online
 - ▶ Face to face classes at ACE (526 Appleyard Drive), Career Source (Blairstone Road), Heritage Trail(Trojan Trail), or B.L. Perry Library
- ▶ Test Prep only, no credits or GPA requirements
- ▶ \$40 per semester

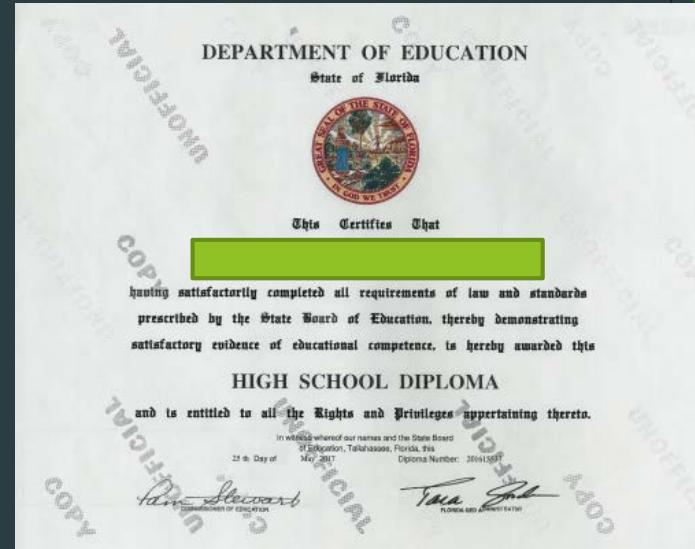


GED[®] Testing

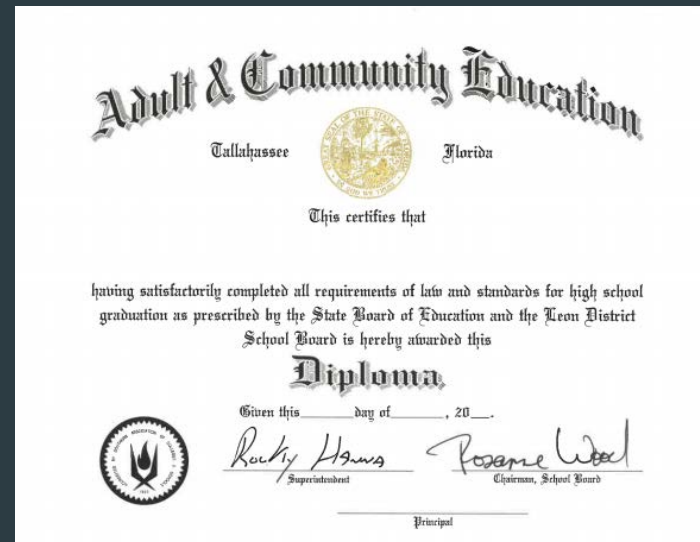
- ▶ GED[®] Ready tests (practice tests) will be taken in the classroom
 - ▶ Students 16 and 17 years old need to pass all 4 sections of the practice test (GED[®] Ready Tests) with a score of 150 or higher before they are able to schedule the GED[®] exam.
- ▶ Students can test at ACE by registering online at www.ged.com
 - ▶ 526 Appleyard Drive-Building 14, on LTC's campus
- ▶ 4 sections of the GED[®] : RLA, Science, Social Studies, Math
 - ▶ Can be taken one section at a time, not all in one day
 - ▶ Tests are \$32 per section, \$128 total for all 4 sections
 - ▶ Retakes are \$12, and you can take a test 3 times before you are locked out for 60 days

Graduation

- ▶ Fall/Spring Graduation held every year
- ▶ State of Florida High School Diplomas are awarded for those who complete the requirements of Adult High School, or pass all sections of the GED® Test.
- ▶ State of Florida High School Diplomas are accepted at Community Colleges, Technical Colleges, and the Military!

ACE ESOL

- ▶ Students age 16 and older
- ▶ Students must be withdrawn from K-12 school
- ▶ Self-paced, small group, and teacher led instruction
- ▶ All levels of students, based on initial assessment
- ▶ Orientation is Thursday each week
 - ▶ Complete online orientation and registration at www.aceleon.org
 - ▶ Wait for email from Maggie Ramrattan-ramrattanm@leonschools.net that will tell you when to come to ACE to complete the enrollment process.
- ▶ Classes offered in the morning, evening, and online
 - ▶ Face to face classes at ACE (526 Appleyard Drive) and Heritage Trail(Trojan Trail
- ▶ \$40 per semester



Career Pathways

- ▶ Providing assistance to students during and after they have completed their program
 - ▶ Student Case Specialist available on campus to all students
 - ▶ Assists with post-secondary education as well as career assessment, interviewing skills, and job placement



Financial Assistance

- ▶ City of Tallahassee TEMPO
 - ▶ Ages 16-24
 - ▶ Pays for tuition, GED study guide, and testing
- ▶ FAMU TRIO
 - ▶ Any age
 - ▶ Pays for testing only
- ▶ CareerSource Capital Region
 - ▶ Any age
 - ▶ Assists with testing as needed
- ▶ Leon County Schools-Graduation Coach Teresa Dennis
 - ▶ Ages 16-18
 - ▶ Pays for tuition, GED study guide, and testing
