
Review of the data related to our primary goal of improving the academic performance of our students indicated that we are closing the gap in some areas toward regaining our "A" school status. Although this year we received an overall grade of "C", we increased in the key area of math with 54% of our students meeting high standards in math. Other highlights include 100% of middle school students meeting high standards in Algebra and 53% of our students meeting high standards in ELA as measured on the 2019 FSA.

Our other goals deal with maintaining a safe, secure, and attractive physical environment and providing the students with an emotionally comfortable yet challenging academic learning atmosphere. Goals related to these areas were met last year. While we have made some progress towards meeting our goals, this year's emphasis will continue to concentrate on goals related to high standards and improvements in all categories.
