COVID Protocols

These are subject to change as directed by the district:

- Masks are optional for all students, faculty members, and visitors to campus.
- Masks are highly recommended for those that are not vaccinated.
- There will be no mask breaks.
- There will no temperature checks/health screenings before school
- If a student develops a fever, they must be fever free for 48 hours before returning to school.



Quarantine Guideline

- If your child is exposed (6 feet or less for 15 minutes) to a COVID positive individual and they are not vaccinated, they will have to quarantine.
- Vaccinated individuals who are showing symptoms must also quarantine.
- You can get a PCR or rapid test on the 7th day after exposure and return to school on day 8 with a negative result and no symptoms.
- You can return to school after 10 days with no test and no symptoms.
- There is no digital academy this year so students who are quarantined should visit their teachers' Canvas pages daily to access assignments.

Student Schedule

- 6 different classes with 6 different teachers
 - 4 core classes (Math, Science, Language Arts, History)
 - 2 electives (which could be an ESE support class and/or an intervention class)
- Lunch is determined by the building location of 3rd period. There are 3 different lunches, all are 26 minutes long.
- Classes are approximately 52 minutes long
- 4 minutes in between classes
- No lockers

Requesting a Schedule Change

- Once schedules are finalized and you are contacted by the school, students and parents have until August 20th to request a schedule change for any reason. We do our best to accommodate your request but we may not be able to due to class size and limited availability.

Promotion Requirements

- To get promoted out of middle school, your student needs to earn 3 credits in each of the four core classes (Math, Science, Language Arts & History).
- To earn a credit, you must earn a total of 4 quality points, and one point must be earned in the 3rd or 4th nine weeks.
 - A = 4 pts
 - B = 3 pts
 - C = 2 pts
 - D = 1 pt
 - F = 0 pts


