What is camp? This is a chance for your incoming student to see the campus before school starts, meet some 6th grade teachers, and become more familiar with the school set up, facilities, and meet new friends.

Welcome to MMS!!! We are so glad that you are joining us at Montford and for our 6th grade camp, "The Making of a Mustang". We are excited to meet our upcoming 6th graders!

I wanted to give you a little more information to prepare you for the camp.

Drop off begins at **8:45-9 AM** in front of the **gym (near main entrance into the school)**. Doors will be locked until that time so that we can set up for the day properly. Our campers should come in alone after the first day, but parents are welcome on day 1. We will have tables with their name badges for them and then they will go to the gym to wait for our meet and greet session that will start at 9AM. I would like to encourage comfortable clothes each day. Phones are welcome to bring but should not be used during camp hours. We will supply all the items needed for camp. No need to bring anything, but your awesome happy camper.

It is important that campers **do not arrive after 9 AM** without making advance arrangements to see if we can accommodate the request. Each camper has a different schedule and rotation for the week, and we do not have enough staff to wait for late campers and take them to their assigned activity. The campers will be put in groups of 25 and will rotate groups throughout the week so that they can meet all the campers throughout the week.

A reminder that camp is **9AM-11:45AM Monday July 29-Thursday August 1st, 2024. LAST DAY IT GOES UNTIL 12:15. Pick up until 12:30.**

At camp we will be learning about the bus/car drop off/pick up routines, sample 6th grade lessons, summer assignment reminders, cafeteria routines, learning to navigate the school, clubs, media center, PE, classes, meeting new friends, learning the Canvas platform, middle school way of work, and much more.
