PREVENTATIVE HEART SCREENING COMPONENTS

- Screenings are provided in collaboration with Wolfson
 Children's Hospital and Tallahassee Memorial Healthcare.
- Screenings consist of:
 - Heart health questionnaire
 - Bilateral blood pressures (BP),
 - Height/weight (BMI)
 - 12-Lead electrocardiogram (ECG/EKG)
- All screenings are reviewed by a board-certified pediatric cardiologist.
- Screenings do not include an echocardiogram.

Please note: If results recommend follow-up with a pediatric cardiologist, your child's primary care physician should be contacted to provide such referral.
