<p>Use an app, photo editor, or Bitmoji to design the main characters from the book however you would like. Then, write or voice note a 5-8 minute discussion between the main characters in which they discuss 3 significant events in the book.</p>	<p>Create a newspaper headline and write an article <u>OR</u> video record at least a 3-minute Breaking News segment about a significant event from the book.</p>	<p>Write a 4-stanza poem about the book. Record or present a dramatic reading of the poem to your ELA class <u>OR</u> set the poem to music and record your song.</p>
<p>Create a movie poster for the book. Include images, words, and phrases that will convince someone to go see the movie.</p>	<p>Create a comic strip (in color) about the novel, highlighting 4 important events from the novel.</p>	<p>Use an app or photo editor to create a “family portrait” of the characters in the book. Then, write or voice note a description of each character, including at least 2 personality traits for each. Use evidence from the book to support the traits you chose.</p>
<p>Design an abstract image of 7 important symbols from the book. Write or voice note a brief explanation of how each symbol is related to the book and what it represents.</p>	<p>Create an Alphabet Book. For each letter of the alphabet, include a word associated with the novel and provide evidence as to why the word you chose is significant.</p>	<p>Design a travel brochure <u>OR</u> create a video for a travel blog that will persuade someone to visit the setting of the book.</p>
