IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT SCHEDULE CHANGES

Each year student schedules are created from this course request form. With a school the size of Chiles, creating student schedules is an extensive and lengthy process requiring hours and hours of diligent work by the scheduling team. The faculty and staff are hired based on the courses requested by students slated to attend Chiles High School. In addition, based on student choices teachers attend summer training opportunities.

Schedule changes will **not** be made for the following reasons:

- Parents requesting certain teachers
- Student has changed his/her mind about elective classes
- Order of classes
- Student requests to lighten his/her academic load (excluding level changes-see below)

It is our mission to ensure that students are enrolled in academic classes that reflect their ability levels. To accomplish this, the Chiles Administration may allow a level change. Level changes are only made under the following conditions:

- The student has completed all class assignments
- There is a teacher recommendation for a level change
- The student has sought help from various sources (teacher, tutoring, etc.)
