- Students should be strongly encouraged to test during the standard testing window of May 11-22. The make-up dates are to be reserved in **case of an emergency**...a power outage when a student tries to sit for the exam in the first window....internet connectivity issues....etc. [View the full testing schedule.](#)
- AP Classroom has enabled all free-response questions to be taken by students at home on any device, *without requiring the LockDown Browser*. The AP Exams will not require a Lockdown Browser either.
- AP Classroom has provided optional, self-paced student practice, with free-response questions to help students practice their knowledge and skills as they prepare for the exam. Students can see scoring criteria from past exams to help revise their responses.
- Any student who does not have access to a device and/or internet should [contact us directly to let us know by April 24](#). An AP Coordinator or teacher may also fill this out on the student's behalf.
