
Parts I and II: Everything should be <u>typed</u>, <u>printed</u>, <u>and brought</u> on the first day of school.

Part II: Personal Writing – Choose <u>ONE</u> of the following topics. Think about the characters in *ATSS* and compare to people in your life. Write a short (300 word) essay.

- 1. In *ATSS*, there were many types of families, both good and bad. Some families in the book are single mother/child, traditional mother/father/child, polygamy, dysfunctional, blended. Discuss what makes a good family, in your opinion and experiences.
- 2. What makes a good mother, in your opinion? Give examples from your own life. You might discuss the mothers -- Nana, Laila, Fariba -- and how Mariam learns to mother in the novel.
- 3. What makes a good father, in your opinion and experience? Evaluate Rasheed, Jalil and Babi as fathers. How does their culture affect their parenting?
