It is a **privilege**, not a right, for students to drive and park on campus. **Parking violations may result in a loss of that privilege.** All campus parking facilities are the property of Leon County School Board and the Board's rules apply. Loitering will not be permitted. All illegally parked cars may be towed at owner's expense as per School Board Policy. **ISS may be assigned to those who park illegally.** The Newman Lot (dirt bowl) is open to *seniors only* with a valid hangtag.

There are 283 total parking spaces on campus. Only juniors and seniors will be permitted to park on campus, once they have purchased a valid hangtag from the Attendance Office. *44 Senior Up-Top parking places are assigned to individual students based upon GPA and class rank.* Only that student may park in that spot. Underclassmen may not park in upper class designated places. Sophomores may purchase parking provided there is a surplus of parking in the fall.

Re-selling of parking permits by students is not permitted. If a student moves, transfers to another school, or is unable to drive for the rest of the year for some reason, he/she is to notify the Attendance Office immediately. Notify the Attendance Office immediately with any vehicle changes.

What to do when someone parks in your parking spot:

- **Do not park in Faculty or Visitor spots.**
- **Do not block cars in.**
- **Seniors, who park up top**, notify the Security Monitor in the Guard Shack, he will guide you to a parking space then report to the Attendance Office and inform Mr. Bell.
- **Seniors who park downstairs**, are to park in the **Junior Bowl**, and report the illegally parked vehicle to Attendance. Attendance will give you a pass to class.
