Dear Parents and Guardians,

I hope you are doing well. I am writing to inform you about important updates regarding the school calendars for the 2024-2025 and 2025-2026 school years.

On May 25, 2025, Superintendent Hanna recommended a revised 2024 – 2025 calendar that will affect our **Class of 2025** seniors. Specifically, our high school seniors will now complete the **2024-2025** school year on **Monday, May 19, 2025**, instead of **Friday, May 16, 2025**.

Similarly, for the 2025-2026 school year, the calendar has been revised to include possible make-up days for hazardous weather on Monday, February 26, 2026 (President's Day) and Friday, April 3, 2026 (Spring Holiday). The end date for our Class of 2026 seniors has been adjusted to Monday, May 18, 2026, instead of Friday, May 15, 2026.

These revisions were discussed and approved by our school community stakeholders, including the Leon County Schools District Advisory Council and the LCS Title I Advisory Council, before being presented at the March 25, 2025, School Board Business Meeting.

These revisions will help us better accommodate any unforeseen weather-related disruptions while ensuring our students' educational needs are met.
