# **Prevention**

- In Grade Level Assemblies, we address RESPECT as a theme
- New Student Orientation, RESPECT is addressed as a theme
- Bullying information has been sent out on Listserv (identifying district's definition of bullying)
- Bullying information and resources will be more accessible via the website
- Parent Liaison will provide bullying materials to students at The 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC Lights On program

# **Education**

- Students are shown the bullying and harassment video to help identify acts and/or behaviors of bullying
- Selected students are entered into Operation Respect counseling offered at the school in 21<sup>st</sup> century program.
- Students and 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC will perform a bullying skit to demonstrate the different types of bullying that can occur on campus
- Local vendor and RHS students will perform a bullying skit during the annual Lights On Celebration to highlight the importance, symptoms of bullying
- A PowerPoint will be available (at teachers' discretion) for them to share with their students
- Distribution of bullying resources to parents and students throughout the school year

## Reporting

- Students are to report instances of bullying to teacher, guidance counselor, or administration to be addressed
- Students are given the district's Report About Possible Bullying/Harassment Incident(s) form, and asked to return it filled out
- Students can locate and fill out a report from by downloading it from the website
- Student/parents can find the reporting form on the district website as well
- As soon as a report is received, it is investigated
- Students can report it to the deputy

## **Correction**

 Selected Students are entered into "Operation Respect" counseling offered at the school during the 21st CCLC program.
