The collection and use of the Social Security number is governed by State Statute S 228.093 and Federal Statute FERPA 6A-1.0955.○ Birth Certificate: Must provide a copy of the student’s birth certificate.○ Immunization Requirements<p>New and transfer students to Leon County Schools, shall provide the school with a Florida Certification of Immunization, DH 680 form (also referred to as a "blue card").</p><p>In addition to all other compulsory school immunizations, <i>seventh grade</i> students are required to have documentation of one dose of Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis (Tdap); and students in <i>grades 8 - 12</i> must have documentation of either a Tetanus-Diphtheria booster (Td) or one dose of Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis (Tdap).</p><p>Needed immunization documentation, described above, must be provided to student's school within 10 days of enrollment. If required documentation is not provided to school within 10 calendar days of enrollment, the student will be excluded from school until needed immunization documentation is received at school.</p><p>In cases where students are transferring within or between public schools in Florida counties, electronic transfer of records will satisfy the record requirements.</p>○ Medical Examination: Students entering a LCS public school for the first time or from out of state or private facility must show proof of physical examination dated within the last year. The student has no more than 10 calendar days to provide documentation of the health exam to the school. Students will be excluded from school if appropriate documentation is not provided.
