DTES EDEP Homework Club



The homework club meets in the afternoon Monday-Thursday from 3:00 - 5:00 p.m. Homework club is available for all students in grades 1st-5th grade who need a quiet place to do their homework. Children may stay in homework club for the amount of time it takes for them to complete any work they then have the option of leaving and going to their assigned activity. This is NOT a one-on-one tutorial session, but where students can receive assistance with questions relating to their subjects. EDEP staff will NOT grade homework.

The Homework Club teacher will be responsible for monitoring completion of the homework that children bring to the program. We are not responsible for grading homework. The EDEP Teachers will be there to answer questions and explain assignments to the extent possible. Please note that we are not a tutoring service.

Homework Club Rules:

Our homework club rules are as follows:

- 1. Children MAY NOT sit next to another child who is doing the same assignment.
- 2. Children must work quietly and independently. If they have any questions, they may ask the Homework Counselor, but <u>MAY NOT</u> get help from another child.
- 3. NO homework will be graded or checked for accuracy.
- 4. The homework counselor will be there to answer questions, but this is <u>NOT</u> designed to be a tutoring center.
- 5. It is the student's responsibility to complete their own homework in Afterschool, just as they would at home.
- 6. If a child is being disruptive in the homework club, they will be asked to leave. Additional consequences will be given to the students who are continually disruptive.
