



Shipwreck Island Checklist

Parents & Guardians,

Here are a few tips, pointers and items to check off of your list to help prepare your camper for this Friday's SUPER fun and exciting field trip to Shipwreck Island! The following are just suggestions for items to make your child comfortable. Camp shirt and a water bottle is not optional. All campers must have a small water bottle due to the heat.

Field Trip Payment Policy – No Cash Accepted

For all upcoming **Summer Camp field trips**, please note that **cash will no longer be accepted** for student purchases.

To ensure a smooth and hassle-free experience, we **strongly encourage parents to provide their child with a prepaid debit card** for any purchases they may wish to make during the trip.

If you're unable to send a debit card with your child, please make sure to explain to them in advance that **chaperones and counselors will not be purchasing items on behalf of students**.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

Prepaid Debit Card Guidelines:

- Prepaid debit cards can be used for **treats, additional beverages, and souvenirs** at Shipwreck Island Waterpark
- While not required, this method is **highly encouraged** for convenience and security.
- **Shipwreck is a NO CASH park**, so prepaid debit cards will be necessary for any on-site purchases.

Turning in Prepaid Debit Cards:

- On the **Monday of the field trip**, prepaid debit cards can be turned in along with any required printed documents from the summer camp checklist.
- **Write your child's name on the back of the card** using a Sharpie.
- **Note the amount on the field trip form** to help with tracking. Also while checking let the Program Director or Assistant Manager know if your child has any restrictions on their spending.

Super Helpful Tips:

1. Set an alarm the night before! The most important thing is to make sure you and your camper are on time! We ask that all of our campers are on campus by 7:45 a.m. sharp. This way we are able to get head counts, use the restroom, assign groups, go over rules and make sure everyone has everything they need before we hit the road.
2. Prepare clothing the night prior! Set out your child's 2025 Summer Camp shirt. All students are required to wear their camp shirt. There is no exception. This is for the safety and well-being of your child. It makes it easier to spot and locate all students with our attire. Please make sure your camper has their bathing suit on under their camp shirt so there are ready when we get to the water park.

4. Use the checklist below to help prepare. These are just suggestions.

Summer Camp Shirt (Mandatory)	Life Jacket for non-swimmers
Water Bottle (Mandatory)	Visor/Hat
Water Shoes	Backpack
Change of Clothes	Electronics/headphones/chargers for bus
Towel	Blanket/Pillow for bus
Plastic Bag for Wet Clothes	Snacks to be left on the bus
Shorts/ Swimwear	Swim goggles
Pre-Paid Visa Card	Make sure your on the remind for trip updates
