- We have begun practicing for the Math Team Competition; with sessions being held on Saturday mornings at the Bethel Baptist Church on West Tennessee Street from 10 am until 12 noon, unless otherwise re-scheduled. The High School (9th/10th grade) Team can still use at least three more team members. The Pre-Test is still up and students can take the test online at FEFonline.org; which is required in order to be on the team. After taking the test, plan to come to the practices on Saturday mornings.
- February 3, 2018 is a very important date for us. It is our annual Black History Brain Bowl (BHBB) Competition. It will be held in the auditorium of Rickards High School, beginning at 9:00 am and ending at approximately 3:00 pm. All Achievers, Believers and Parents are asked to support the Teams participating in this event. Teams have already begun working and are excited to share with you, what they have learned about Black History in particular. Please make plans to spend the full day with us. Parents, I will need your volunteer assistance with set-up of serving food to participating Teams, etc..

The winning high school team, will represent our Center in the State Summit BHBB Competition in Orlando in March. Achievers and Believers are asked to wear their T-Shirts with jeans or a pair of slacks for this activity. The plan is to have a "Food Truck" on campus for you to purchase your lunch. (ABSOLUTELY No eating in the auditorium please!!!)

• March is our next important and busy month. March 23-25, 2018, are the official dates for the SUMMIT and State BHBB Competition. The summit is our State-wide Achievers/Believers Conference; open to all students and parents. We will depart via Charter Bus for the Summit/BHBB Competition on Thursday morning, March 22nd and return on Saturday evening. It has been the custom to have all participating students excused from school during those particular school days. That same request will be made this year as well. Therefore, it is imperative that a decision is made soon, as to whether or not your child/children will attend this conference.

One of the parents sent me the Testing Schedule. From what I can see, it does not appear to be any conflicts of testing days with our travel schedule. No shorts for males or females at any time during the trip.

After reading the information sheets at the FEF Website, regarding additional competitions being held during the Summit, please let me know NO LATER than FEBRUARY 1, 2018 of your desire to have your child participate. Three of the events are for individual participants; while the NAS Codes Competition may consist of a single member team or up to a 3 member team. Go to the website at www.fefonline.org if you don't have the info I sent out earlier. Let me know if you have questions about any of the competitions and I will be happy to answer them. Parents, I will also need you as volunteers to work as chaperones with the students/teams during the Summit as well.

Remember the deadline for sign-up is FEBRUARY 1, 2018 for competitions! This is also the date you must let me know if you plan to attend the Summit. Shortly after that date, a deposit towards the per person fee of \$200.00 will be due. Okay, I hope you have read closely, all the way to the bottom. Everything here is soooo important!
