

2017-2018 JLT Teen Board Information and Application

TEEN BOARD OVERVIEW

The Junior League of Tallahassee (JLT) is excited to recruit the 5th annual Teen Board, selecting high school junior and senior female leaders in our community to serve a one-year term (September 2017 – May 2018). The JLT Teen Board provides a foundation of volunteerism and offers the opportunity for Teen Board members to gain an understanding of the impact JLT has on the Tallahassee community, while earning needed volunteer hours for college and scholarship applications. Members of the JLT Teen Board will receive training from JLT members and community leaders to help with success through the remainder of high school, college, and beyond. Teen Board members will have opportunities to volunteer at key JLT projects and for projects throughout the community. In addition, the teen participants will have the benefit of interacting with other young women their age from across the community.

WHO IS JLT?

JLT was established in 1960 by a group of visionary women committed to serving the community in a volunteer capacity. Today, JLT has nearly 500 members, both active and sustaining, and remains committed to developing the potential of women as leaders and grassroots volunteers in charitable causes that improve our local community. This year alone, we will contribute more than 10,000 volunteer hours to promote our mission and improve the lives of local children and families. JLT and the Association of Junior Leagues International reach out to women of all races, religions, and national origins who demonstrate an interest in and commitment to volunteerism.

JLT MISSION

JLT is a nonprofit organization of women committed to improving the lives of children and families through the effective action and leadership of trained volunteers. Its purpose is exclusively educational and charitable.

JLT IMPACT AREA

School success: Our community projects provide children and families the opportunities to succeed in school through health, self-esteem, and basic needs.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS AND TIMELINE

Thank you for your interest in the 2017-2018 JLT Teen Board. Please carefully review the expectations, criteria, and commitment to the Teen Board, and complete the application below. Applications are due no later than **Friday**, **April 28**, **2017**, and should be submitted via email to teenboard@iltallahassee.org. All applications will be reviewed by JLT members. Interviews will take place **during the week of May 1**, **2017**. Applicants will be notified via email to sign up for an interview time, and interviews will last approximately 15 minutes. The selected 2017-2018 Teen Board will be announced no later than **Friday**, **May 12**, **2017**.

WHAT TO EXPECT

You can expect the following by participating in the 2017-2018 JLT Teen Board:

- 1. Gain valuable volunteer training.
- 2. Earn volunteer hours to showcase on college and scholarship applications.
- 3. Interact with other young women your age from across the community.
- 4. Meet local nonprofit and community leaders.
- 5. Grow and develop as a leader and a volunteer.

CRITERIA

Applicants must be:

- 1. In the 11th or 12th grade during the 2017-2018 school year and attend a school in Leon, Gadsden, or Wakulla County, or be home-schooled as a Leon, Gadsden, or Wakulla County resident.
- 2. Identified by school administrators or other community leaders as having leadership potential (teachers, administrators, coaches, instructors, faith community, neighbor, employer, etc.).
- 3. Interested in learning more about volunteer and leadership opportunities in our community.
- 4. Interested in putting skills gained in Teen Board training to use in our community.
- 5. Positive and enthusiastic about networking with other local high school teens.
- 6. Willing to commit the energy necessary to gain a meaningful experience as a JLT Teen Board member.
- 7. Willing to consistently participate in meetings and activities.

Applicants must have:

- 1. A minimum of 2.5 GPA, unweighted.
- 2. Signed consent of their parent/guardian at the end of the application.
- 3. Signed consent of their parent/guardian for the Teen Board waiver, if selected (included in this application).

COMMITMENT TO THE TEEN BOARD

The JLT Teen Board requires a level of commitment and dedication from each selected member in order to provide a successful and meaningful experience.

- Members are expected to participate in <u>all</u> JLT Teen Board events and activities unless they have communicated with the Teen Board Chairs to be excused from an event.
- There will be monthly Teen Board training meetings, and those dates will be set with the teens in order to achieve the best participation and attendance.
- Teen Board members commit to volunteer for a minimum of three (3) shifts at a JLT community project or fundraiser, based upon Teen Board member's schedule and availability. The members will be notified of volunteer opportunities as they arise.
- There is a \$20 scholarship/activities fee once you are chosen for the 2017-2018 JLT Teen Board. If for any reason you are unable to pay the fee, please let the Teen Board Chairs know. Not paying the fee does not preclude the member from participating in Teen Board.
