Arrival and Dismissal Procedures Morning student drop-off procedures:

Parents may begin dropping off students at 7:45 until 8:30 in the back of the school entering from Buck Lake Road.
If you want to park and walk your student to their designated area, please use one of the parking spaces at the front of the school or in the overflow parking (first week only).
The driveway at the front of the school is only for buses and day care vans.
Do not park at the back of the school.

Afternoon student dismissal:

Afternoon supervision is from 2:45 – 3:20.
The back gates open at 2:15. (Do not block the gate.) Please do not line up before 2:15 as this backs up traffic.
Parent pick-up will be at the back of the school. Please do not block the lanes of traffic.

Dismissal begins at 2:45 for K-1-2 and at
 2:50 for 3-4-5. If you have younger and older students, please come at the later time.

Please remember that you cannot block traffic on Buck Lake, or you may get a ticket for obstructing the flow of traffic.

You may not park in the front parking lot and walk into the building to get your child or to the gathering place. We cannot mix foot traffic with bus traffic.

□ If you are walking in to meet your student, do not park in the front parking lot. You may meet them at the Gathering Place at 2:45. (The Gathering Place is located in the covered area near the portables near the front of the school.)

Other Important Information:

□ Parents/Volunteers may park in the front of the school in the parking lot from 8:30 to 2:15 to take care of school business. You must be gone by 2:15 or stay until all the buses are gone (about 3:10).

□ Please do not drop off your child on Pedrick Road in front of the school. THIS IS UNSAFE AND WE WANT NO CHILD HIT BY A CAR.

□ Also, please do not pull through the front parking lot and drop off your child as this is unsafe.
