

Academic Enrichment Courses (S.T.E.A.M):

> Science

Experiment like a Trojan.

Referencing the Science Next Generation Sunshine State Standards (SNGSSS), instructors will expound on school day topics in a fun and engaging problem-based manner. Students will increase scientific vocabulary and make connections with hands-on activities that range across varied scientific topics. Students will also replicate various forms of mass and matter to experience relevant assimilation in a creative manner. Instructors will integrate the use of technology to further reinforce scientific standards and goals. Activities will be based largely on the Sally Ride Project; however, relevant Model Eliciting Activities will be infused into unit plans for extension opportunities.

> Technology

Design like a Trojan.

In conjunction with the all Florida State Standards directly connected to Technology ranging from Language Arts to Mathematics, students will utilize several technology suites to support the associated tasks set forth by the Sally Ride Project or the applicable Model Eliciting Activities and lessons. Students will interact with the following Microsoft suites to maintain both quality and quantitative data: Microsoft Word, Microsoft Excel, Microsoft PowerPoint, and a host of synchronous and asynchronous programs utilized to build technology awareness and application.

Engineering

Build like a Trojan.

Based on the associated Florida State Science, Math, Social Studies and Language Arts Standards, Engineering instructors will implement the tasks outlined in the following units: Transportation and Energy, Roadway Geometry, Humans and Nature, and Designing Ways. These components of R.I.D.E.S (Roadways in Developing Elementary/Secondary Students) explore both math and science as it relates to transportation with an emphasis on the following skill sets: classification, sequencing, measuring, graphing, predicting, inferring, and experimenting. Select Model Eliciting Activities will also be utilized for this the engineering component.

> Math

Count like a Trojan.

Utilizing the Mathematics Florida Standards (MAFS), instructors will facilitate student collaboration and interaction with relevant math manipulatives and other hands-on stimulants to reinforce standards and objectives taught during the regular school day. Instructors will utilize systematic projects based on Model Eliciting Activities that connect with unit topics and program themes. Students will gain further insight on how math, and all of its components, connects with career choices and everyday problem solving.
